



Hope St Parklet

WHAT IS THE HOPE ST PARKLET?

- Hope St Parklet is located at the southwest corner of Hope and 11th Street, just a few blocks south of STAPLES Center, L.A. Live, and the Metro Pico Station.
- The Parklet replaces two parking spots, providing a new public green space complete with planters and seating for people to meet, talk, and enjoy the neighborhood.

WHO BROUGHT THIS PROJECT TO SOUTH PARK?

- Hope St Parklet is managed and maintained by the South Park Business Improvement District (BID), who applied under the People St program and was selected to partner with the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT).
- As a part of South Park's Walkability Project, South Park BID worked with various sponsors and partners to bring this new pedestrian-friendly public space to life.

HOW IS THIS PROJECT FINANCED?

- Funds for parklet materials, design, and labor were largely donated by members of the South Park community, including SODA Architects, Mia Lehrer + Associates, Mack Urban, Benchmark + Tishman Construction, A Joint Venture, Swinerton Builders, Trumark Urban, Hazens Group, USA, ValleyCrest Landscape Development, Harry H. Joh Construction, ABC Resources, Tinco Sheet Metal, Helix Electric.
- As the Community Partner for this project, the South Park BID has contributed their own funds and is responsible for ongoing maintenance of the Parklet.
- Because the People St program is a public-private partnership, LADOT has provided technical assistance, project support, and wayfinding signage.

IS THIS PROJECT PERMANENT?

- People St Parklets are temporary installations under an annual renewable agreement between LADOT and the Community Partner, South Park BID.
