WHAT ARE THE MOTOR AVE PARKLETS?

- The Motor Ave Parklets are located on Palms' diverse commercial corridor, Motor Avenue, just north and south of National Boulevard.
- The Parklets take the place of 1-2 parking spots -- providing people with new public spaces adjacent to shops, cafés, a community garden, and Farmer's Market.

WHO BROUGHT THIS PROJECT TO PALMS?

- Motor Ave Parklets are managed and maintained by the Motor Avenue Improvement Association (MAIA) who applied under the People St program and were selected to partner with the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT).
- As a part of MAIA's ongoing efforts to create a more pedestrian and bicycle-friendly environment along Motor Avenue, MAIA worked with various sponsors and partners to bring these two new public spaces to life.

HOW IS THIS PROJECT FINANCED?

- Funds for parklet materials, design, and labor were largely donated by sponsors who are active members of the Palms community, including Hathaway Construction Company, JMB Realty Corporation, and Community Assets Consulting.
- As the Community Partner for this project, MAIA has contributed their own funds and is responsible for ongoing maintenance of both Parklets.

IS THIS PROJECT PERMANENT?

- People St Parklet projects are temporary installations under a 1-year, renewable MOU between LADOT and the Community Partner, Motor Avenue Improvement Association.
